Event Description: Aggregate- The two-hour written exam is open book and consists of approximately 100 multiple choice questions. There are 8 to 12 questions on each of the Standards. The performance examination is closed book and requires actual demonstration of the required Standards. The examinee is judged on ability to correctly perform or describe all of the required procedures for each standard.

Strength- The one-hour written exam is closed book and consists of approximately 40 multiple choice questions. There are at least 8 questions on the ASTM Standards. The performance examination is also "closed book" and requires actual demonstration of the required ASTM Standards. The examinee is judged on ability to correctly perform or describe all of the required procedures for each standard.
